Student Laboratory Safety Rules Agreement

CPG Laboratories

Safety is a priority in all laboratory activities at KFUPM. To ensure a safe and responsible environment, students must follow the safety guidelines provided. By signing this agreement, students acknowledge that they understand and agree to abide by these rules.

General Safety Guidelines

(Please read these safety guidelines, complete, sign the last page, and give it to your instructor)

1. Responsible Conduct

 Always behave responsibly in the lab. Horseplay, practical jokes, and pranks are strictly prohibited.

2. Instructions

• Follow all written and verbal instructions carefully. Seek clarification from the instructor if anything is unclear.

3. Equipment Use

 Do not touch any equipment or materials unless given permission by the instructor.

4. Authorized Experiments

 Only perform experiments that have been authorized and supervised by the instructor.

5. No Food or Drink

• Eating, drinking, or chewing gum is not allowed in the lab.

6. Safety Goggles

 Wear safety goggles when instructed. Goggles must not be removed during experiments.

7. Hand Hygiene

 Avoid touching your face, eyes, and mouth during lab work. Wash your hands thoroughly after leaving the lab.



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8. Clean Work Area

• Keep your workspace clean and organized. Only essential items, such as lab instructions, manuals, and writing tools, should be in the work area.

9. Chemical Handling

Handle chemicals carefully and avoid contact with your skin, eyes, and clothing.
Report spills or broken equipment to the instructor immediately.

10. Supervised Experiments

 Never leave an experiment unattended unless instructed to do so. If necessary, ask a classmate to watch your experiment.

11. Fire Safety

 In case of a fire drill, turn off all gas valves and electrical equipment before leaving the lab. Go to fire master points (nearest to your lab)

12. Incident Reporting

Report any safety concerns or incidents to the instructor immediately.

13. Emergency Contact

 In case of an emergency, call 999 from a campus phone or 013-860-9999 from a mobile phone.
